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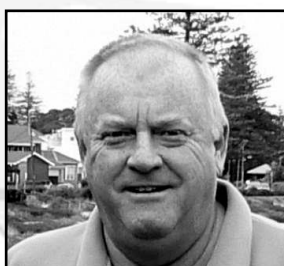

## PART 1

### PRELIMINARY

#### INTERPRETATION

##### 1

1. In these rules, except in so far as the context or subject matter otherwise indicates or requires –  
“ordinary member” means a member of the committee who is not an office-bearer of the association, as referred to in rule 13(2);

“secretary” means-

- (a) the person holding office under these rules as secretary of the associations; or
- (b) where no such person holds that office – the public officer of the association;

“special general meeting” means a general meeting of the association other than annual general meeting;

“the Act” means the Associations Incorporation Act, 1985;

2. In these rules-

- (a) a reference to a function includes a reference to a power, authority and duty; and
- (b) a reference to the exercise of a function includes, where the functions is a duty, a reference to the performance of the duty.

3. The provisions of the Interpretation Act, 1987, apply to and in respect of these rules in the same manner as those provisions would so apply if these rules were an instrument made under the Act.

## PART II

### MEMBERSHIP

#### MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

2. A person is qualified to be a member of the association if, but only if-

- (a) the person is a person referred to in section 15(1)(a), (b) or (c) of the Act and has not ceased to be a member of the association at any time after incorporation of the Association under the Act; or
- (b) the person is a natural person who-
  - (i) has been nominated for membership of the association as provided by rule 3; and
  - (ii) has been approved for membership of the association by the committee of the association .

#### NOMINATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

##### 3.

1. A nomination of a person for membership of the associations-
  - (a) shall be made by a member of the association in writing in the form set out in Appendix 1 to these rules; and
  - (b) shall be lodged with the secretary of the association.



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2. As soon as practicable after receiving a nomination for membership, the secretary shall refer the nomination to the committee which shall determine whether to approve or to reject the nomination.
3. Where the committee determines to approve a nomination for membership, the secretary shall, as soon as practicable after that determination, notify the nominee of that approval and request the nominee to pay within the period of 28 days after receipt by the nominee of the notification the sum payable under these rules by a member as entrance fee and annual subscription.
4. The secretary shall, on payment by the nominee of the amounts referred to in clause (3) within the period referred to in that clause, enter the nominee's name in the register of members and, upon the name being so entered, the nominee becomes a member of the association.

## CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

4. A person ceases to be a member of the association if the person-
  - (a) dies;
  - (b) resigns that membership; or
  - (c) is expelled from the association.
  - (d) Nominates for the position of Director or Executive of the St George Motor Boat Club while being a member of the association

## MEMBERSHIP ENTITLEMENTS NOT TRANSFERABLE

5.
  - A right, privilege or obligation which a person has by reason of being a member of the association-
    - (a) is not capable of being transferred or transmitted to another person; and
    - (b) terminates upon cessation of the person's membership.

## RESIGNATION OF MEMBERSHIP

6.
  1. A member of the association is not entitled to resign that membership except in accordance with this rule.
  2. A member of the association who has paid all amounts payable by the member to the association in respect of the member's membership may resign from membership of the association by first giving notice (being not less than 1 month or not less than such other period as the committee may determine) in writing to the secretary of the member's intention to resign and, upon the expiration of the period of notice, the member ceases to be a member.
  3. Where a member of the association ceases to be a member pursuant to clause (2), and in every other case where a members recoding the date on which the member ceased to be a member.

## REGISTRATION OF MEMBERS

- 7.



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1. The public officer of the association shall establish and maintain a register of members of the association specifying the name and address of each person who is a member of the association together with the date on which the person became a member.
2. The register of members shall be kept at the principal place of administration of the association and shall be open for inspection, free of charge, by any member of the association at any reasonable hour.

## FEES, SUBSCRIPTIONS ETC.

8.

1. A member of the association shall, upon admission to membership, pay to the association a fee of \$1 or, where some other amount is determined by the committee, of that other amount.
2. In addition to any amount payable by the member under clause (1), a member of the association shall pay to the association an annual or multiple year membership fee of \$2, or, where some other amount is determined by the committee, of that other amount-
  - (a) except as provided by paragraph (b), before 1<sup>st</sup> July in each calendar year; or
  - (b) where the member becomes a member on or after 1<sup>st</sup> July in any calendar year – upon becoming a member and before 1<sup>st</sup> July in the year that their membership expires.

## MEMBER'S LIABILITIES

9.

The liability of a member of the association to contribute towards the payment of the debts and liabilities of the association or the cost, charges and expenses of the winding up of the association is limited to the amount, if any, unpaid by the member in respect of the membership of the association as required by rule 8.

## RESOLUTIONS OF INTERNAL DISPUTES

9A.

Disputes between members (in their capacity as members) of the association, and disputes between members and the association, are to be referred to a community justice centre for mediation in accordance with the Community Justice Centres Act, 1983.

## DISCIPLINING OF MEMBERS

10.

1. Where the committee is of the opinion that a member of the association-
  - (a) has persistently refused or neglected to comply with a provision or provisions of these rules; or
  - (b) has persistently and wilfully acted in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the association, the committee may, by resolutions-
  - (c) expel the member from the association; or
  - (d) suspend the member from membership of the association for specified period.
2. A resolution of the committee under clause (1) is of no effect unless the committee, at a meeting held not earlier than 14 days and not later than 28 days after service on the member of a notice under



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clause (3), confirms the resolution in accordance with this rule.

3. Where the committee passes a resolution under clause (1), the secretary shall, as soon as practicable, cause a notice in writing to be served on the member-
  - (a) setting out the resolution of the committee and the grounds on which it is based;
  - (b) stating that the member may address the committee at a meeting to be held not earlier than 14 days and not later than 28 days after service of the notice;
  - (c) stating the date, place and time of that meeting; and
  - (d) informing the member that the member may do either or both of the following;
    - (i) attend and speak at meeting;
    - (ii) submit to the committee at or prior to the date of the meeting written representation relating to the resolution.
4. At a meeting of the committee held as referred to in clause (3), the committee shall-
  - (a) give to the member an opportunity to make oral representations;
  - (b) give due consideration to any written representation submitted to the committee by the member at or prior to the meeting; and
  - (c) by resolution determine whether to confirm or revoke the resolutions.
5. Where the committee confirms a resolution under clause (4), the secretary shall, within 7 days after that confirmation, by notice in writing inform the member of the fact and of the member's right of appeal under rule 11.
6. A resolution confirmed by the committee under clause (4) does not take effect-
  - (a) until the expiration of the period within which the member is entitled to appeal against the resolution where the member does not exercise the right of appeal within that period; or
  - (b) where within that period the member exercises the right of appeal, unless and until the association confirms the resolution pursuant to rule 11(4).

## RIGHT OF APPEAL OF DISCIPLINED MEMBER

### 11.

1. A member may appeal to the association in general meeting against a resolution of the committee which is confirmed under rule 10(4), within 7 days after the notice of resolution is served on the member by logging with the secretary a notice to that effect.
2. Upon receipt of a notice from a member under clause (1), the secretary shall notify the committee which shall convene a general meeting of the association to be held within 21 days after the date on which secretary received the notice.
3. At a general meeting of the association convened under clause (2)-
  - (a) no business other than the question of the appeal shall be transacted;
  - (b) the committee and the member shall be given the opportunity to state their respective cases orally or in writing, or both; and
  - (c) the members present shall vote by secret ballot on the question of whether the resolution should be confirmed or revoked.
4. If at the general meeting the association passes a special resolution in favour of the confirmation of the resolution, the resolution is confirmed.



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## PART III

### THE COMMITTEE

#### POWERS, ETC. OF COMMITTEE

12. The committee shall be called the committee of management of the association and, subject to the Act, the Regulation and these rules and to any resolution passed by the association in general meeting-

- (a) shall control and manage the affairs of the association;
- (b) may exercise all such functions as may be exercised by the association other than those functions that are required by these rules to be exercised by a general meeting of the members of the association; and
- (c) has power to perform all such acts and do all such things as appear to the committee to be necessary or desirable for the proper management of the affairs of the association.

#### CONSTITUTION AND MEMBERSHIP

13.

1. Subject in the case of the first members of the committee to section 21 of the Act, the committee shall consist of-
  - (a) the office-bearers of the association; and
  - (b) 3 ordinary members;each of whom shall be elected at the annual general meeting of the association pursuant to rule 14.
2. The office-bearers of the association shall be-
  - (a) the president;
  - (b) the vice-president;
  - (c) the treasurer; and
  - (d) the secretary.
3. Each member of the committee shall, subject to these rules, hold office until the conclusion of the annual general meeting following the date of the member's election, but is eligible for re-election.
4. In the event of a casual vacancy occurring in the membership of the committee, the committee may appoint a member of the association to fill the vacancy and the member so appointed shall hold office, subject to these rules, until the conclusion of the annual general meeting next following the date of the appointment.

#### ELECTION OF MEMBERS

14.

1. Nominations of candidates for election as office-bearers of the association or as ordinary members of the committee-
  - (a) shall be made in writing, signed by 2 members of the association and accompanied by the written consent of the candidate (which may be endorsed on the form of nomination); and
  - (b) shall be delivered to the secretary of the association not less than 14 days before the date fixed for the holding of the annual general meeting at which the election is to take place.

2. If insufficient nominations are received to fill all vacancies on the committee, the candidates nominated shall be deemed elected and further nominations shall be received at the annual general meeting.
3. If insufficient further nominations are received, any vacant position remaining on the committee shall be deemed to be casual vacancies.
4. If the number of nominations received is equal to the number of vacancies to be filled, the persons nominated shall be deemed elected.
5. If the number of nomination received exceeds the number of vacancies to be filled, a ballot shall be held.
6. The ballot for the election of office-bearers and ordinary members of the committee shall be conducted at the annual general meeting in such usual and proper manner as the committee may direct.
7. A nomination of a candidate for election under this clause is not valid if that candidate has been nominated for election to another office at the same election.

## SECRETARY

15.

1. The secretary of the association shall, as soon as practicable after being appointed as secretary, lodge notice with the association of his or her address.
2. It is the duty of the secretary to keep minutes of-
  - (a) all appointments of office-bearers and members of the committee;
  - (b) the names of members of the committee present at a committee meeting or general meeting;and
  - (c) all proceedings at committee meetings and general meetings.
3. Minutes of proceedings at a meeting shall be signed by the chairperson of the meeting or the chairperson of the next succeeding meeting.

## TREASURER

16.

- It is the duty of the treasurer of the association to ensure that-
- (a) all money due to the association is collected and received and that all payments authorised by the association are made; and
  - (b) correct books and accounts are kept showing the financial affairs of the association including full details of all receipts and expenditure connected with the activities of the association.

## CASUAL VACANCIES

17.

- For the purposes of these rules, a casual vacancy in the office of a member of the committee occurs if the member-

- (a) dies;
- (b) ceased to be a member of the association;
- (c) becomes an insolvent under administration within the meaning of Corporations Law;
- (d) resigns office by notice in writing given to the secretary;
- (e) is removed from office under rule 18;
- (f) become of unsound mind or a person whose person or estate is liable to be dealt with in any way under the law relating to mental health; or
- (g) is absent without the consent of the committee from all meetings of the committee held during a period of 6 months.

## REMOVAL OF MEMBER

18.

1. The association in general meeting may by resolution remove any member of the committee from the office of member before the expiration of the member's term of office and may by resolution appoint another person to hold office until the expiration of the term of office of the member so removed.
2. Where a member of the committee to whom a proposed resolution referred to in clause (1) relates makes representations in writing to the secretary or president (not exceeding a reasonable length) and requests that the representations be notified to the members of the association, the secretary or the president may send a copy of the representation to each member of the association or, if the representation are not so sent, the member is entitled to require that the representations be read out the meeting at which the resolution is considered.

## MEETINGS AND QUORUM

19.

1. The committee shall meet at least 12 times in each period of 12 months as such place and time as the committee may determine.
2. Additional meetings of the committee may be convened by the president or by any member of the committee.
3. Oral or written notice of a meeting of the committee shall be given by the secretary to each member of the committee at least 48 hours (or such other period as may be unanimously agreed upon by the members of the committee) before the time appointed for the holding of the meeting.
4. Notice of the meeting given under clause 93) shall specify the general nature of the business to be transacted at the meeting and no business other than that business shall be transacted at the meeting, except business which the committee members present at the meeting unanimously agree to treat as urgent business.
5. Any 3 members of the committee constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of a meeting of the committee.
6. No business shall be transacted by the committee unless a quorum is present and if within half an hour of the time appointed for the meeting a quorum is not present the meeting stands adjourned to



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the same place and at the same hour of the same day in the following week.

7. If at the adjourned meeting a quorum is not present within half an hour of the time appointed for the meeting, the meeting shall be dissolved.
8. At a meeting of the committee-
  - (a) the president, or in the president's absence, the vice-president, shall preside; or
  - (b) If the president and vice-president are absent or unwilling to act such one of the remaining members of the committee as may be chosen by the members present at the meeting shall preside.

## DELEGATION BY COMMITTEE TO SUB-COMMITTEE

20.

1. The committee may, by instrument in writing, delegate to one or more sub-committees (consisting or such member or members of the association as the committee thinks fit) the exercise of such of the functions of the committee as are specified in the instrument, other than-
  - (a) this power of delegation; and
  - (b) a function which is a duty imposed on the committee by the Act or by any other law.
2. A function of the exercise of which has been delegated to a sub-committee under this rule may, while the delegation remains unrevoked, be exercised from time to time by the sub-committee in accordance with the terms of the delegation.
3. A delegation under this section may be made subject to such conditions or limitations as to the exercise of any function the subject thereof, or as to time or circumstances, as may be specified in the instrument of delegation.
4. Notwithstanding any delegation under this rule, the committee may continue to exercise any function delegated.
5. Any act or thing done or suffered by a sub-committee acting in the exercise of delegation under this rule has the same force and effect as it would have if it had been done or suffered by the committee.
6. The committee may, by instrument in writing, revoke wholly or in part any delegation under this rule.
7. A sub-committee may meet and adjourn as it thinks proper.

## VOTING AND DECISIONS

21.

1. Questions arising at a meeting of the committee or sub-committee appointed by the committee shall be determined by a majority of the votes of members of the committee or sub-committee present at the meeting.
2. Each member present at the meeting of the committee or sub-committee appointed by the committee (including the person presiding at the meeting) is entitled to one vote but, in the event of an equality of votes on any question, the person presiding may exercise a second or casting vote.

3. Subject to rule 19(5), the committee may act notwithstanding any vacancy on the committee.
4. Any act or thing done or suffered, or purporting to have been done or suffered, by the committee or by a sub-committee appointed by the committee, is valid and effectual notwithstanding any defect that may afterwards be discovered in the appointment or qualification of any member of the committee or sub-committee.

## PART IV

### GENERAL MEETINGS

#### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS – HOLDING OF

##### 22.

1. With the exception of the first annual general meeting of the association, the association shall, at least once in each calendar year and within the period of 6 months after the expiration of each financial year of the association, convene an annual general meeting of its members.
2. The association shall hold its first annual general meeting-
  - (a) within the period of 18 months after is incorporation under the Act; and
  - (b) within the period of 6 months after expiration of the first financial year of the association.
3. Clauses (1) and (2) have effect subject to any extension or permission granted by the Commission under section 26(3) of the Act.

#### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS – CALLING OF AND BUSINESS AT

##### 23.

1. The annual general meeting of the association shall, subject to the Act and to rule 22, be convened on such date and at such place and time as the committee thinks fit.
2. In addition to any other business which may be transacted at an annual general meeting, the business of an annual general meeting shall be-
  - (a) to confirm the minute of the last preceding annual general meeting and of any special general meeting held since that meeting;
  - (b) to receive from the committee reports upon the activities of the association during the last preceding financial year;
  - (c) to elect office-bearers of the association and ordinary members of the committee; and
  - (d) to receive and consider the statement which is required to be submitted to members pursuant to section 26960 of the Act.
3. An annual general meeting shall be specified as such in the notice convening it.

#### SPECIAL GENERAL MEETINGS – CALLING OF

##### 24.

1. The committee may, whenever it thinks fit, convene a special general meeting of the association.

2. The committee shall, on the requisition in writing of not less than 10 percent of the total number of members, convene a special general meeting of the association.
3. A requisition of member for a special general meeting-
  - (a) shall state the purpose or purposes of the meeting;
  - (b) shall be signed by the member making the requisitions;
  - (c) shall be lodged with the secretary; and
  - (d) may consist of several documents in a similar form, each signed by one or more of the members making the requisition.
4. If the committee fails to convene a special general meeting to be held within 1 months after that date on which a requisition of members for the meeting is lodged with the secretary, any one or more of the members who made the requisition may convene a special general meeting to be held not later than 3 months after that date.
5. A special general meeting convened by a member or members as referred to in clause (4) shall be convened as nearly as is practicable in the same manner as general meetings are convened by the committee and any member who thereby incurs expense is entitled to be reimbursed by the association for any expense so incurred.

## NOTICE

### 25.

1. Except where the nature of the business proposed to be dealt with at a general meeting requires a special resolution of the association, the secretary shall, at least 14 days before the date fixed for the holding of the general meeting, cause to be sent by pre-paid post to each member at the member's address appearing in the register of members, a notice specifying the place, date and time of the meeting and the nature of the business proposed to be transacted at the meeting.
2. Where the nature of the business proposed to be dealt with at a general meeting requires a special resolution of the association, the secretary shall, at least 21 days before the date fixed for the holding of the general meeting, cause notice to be sent to each member in the manner provided in clause (1) specifying, in addition to the matter required under clause (1), the intention to propose the resolution as a special resolution.
3. No business other than that specified in the notice convening a general meeting shall be transacted at the meeting except, in the case of an annual general meeting, business which may be transacted pursuant to rule 23(2).
4. A member desiring to bring any business before a general meeting may give notice in writing of that business to the secretary, who shall include that business in the next notice calling a general meeting given after receipt of the notice from the member.

## PROCEDURE

### 26.

1. No item of business shall be transacted at a general meeting unless a quorum of members entitled under these rules to vote is present during the time the meeting is considering that item.

2. Five members present in person (being members entitled under these rules to vote at a general meeting) constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of a general meeting.
3. If within half an hour after the appointed time for the commencement of a general meeting a quorum is not present, the meeting if convened upon the requisition of members shall be dissolved and in any other case shall stand adjourned to the same day in the following week at the time and (unless another place is specified at the time of the adjournment by the person presiding at the meeting or communicated by written notice to members given before the day which the meeting is adjourned) at the same place.
4. If at the adjourned meeting a quorum is not present within half an hour after the appointed for the commencement of the meeting, the members present (being not less than 3) shall constitute a quorum.

## PRESIDING MEMBER

27.

1. The president or, in the president's absence, the vice-president, shall preside as chairperson at each general meeting of the association.
2. If the president and the vice-president are absent from a general meeting or unwilling to act, the members present shall elect one of their number to preside as chairperson at the meeting.

## ADJOURNMENT

28.

1. The chairperson of a general meeting at which a quorum is present may, with the consent of the majority of members present at the meeting, adjourn the meeting from time to time and place to place, but no business shall be transacted at an adjourned meeting other than the business left unfinished at the meeting which the adjournment took place.
2. Where a general meeting is adjourned for 14 days or more, the secretary shall give written or oral notice of the adjourned meeting to each member of the association stating the place, date and time of the meeting and the nature of the business to be transacted at the meeting.
3. Except as provided in clauses (1) and (2), notice of an adjournment of a general meeting or of the business to be transacted at an adjourned meeting is not required to be given.

## MAKING OF DECISIONS

29.

1. A question arising at a general meeting of the association shall be determined on a show of hand and, unless before or on the declaration of the show of hands a poll is demanded, a declaration by the chairperson that a resolution has, on a show of hands, been carried or carried unanimously or carried by a particular majority or lost, or an entry to that effect in the minute book of the association, is evidence of the fact without proof of the number or proportion of the votes recorded in favour of or against that resolution.

2. At a general meeting of the association, a poll may be demanded by the chairperson or by not less than 3 members present in person or my proxy at the meeting.
3. Where a poll is demanded at a general meeting, the poll shall be taken-
  - (a) immediately in the case of a poll which relates to the election of the chairperson of the meeting or to the question of an adjournment; or
  - (b) in any other case, in such manner and at such time before the close of the meeting as the chairperson directs, and the resolution of the poll on the matter shall be deemed to be the resolution of the meeting on that matter.

## SPECIAL RESOLUTIONS

30.

1. A resolution of the association is a special resolution if-
  - (a) it is passed by a majority which comprises not less than three-quarters of such members of the association as, being entitled under these rules so to do, vote in person or by proxy at a general meeting of which not less than 21 days written notice specifying the intention to propose the resolution as a special resolution was given in accordance with these rules; or
  - (b) where it is made to appear to the Commission that it is not possible or practicable for the resolution to be passed in the manner specified in paragraph (a) – the resolution is passed in a manner specified by the Commission.

## VOTING

31.

1. Upon any question arising at a general meeting of the association, a member has one vote only.
2. All votes shall be given personally or by proxy but no member may hold more than 5 proxies.
3. In the case of an equality of votes on a question at a general meeting, the chairperson of the meeting is entitled to exercise a second or casting vote.
4. A member or proxy is not entitled to vote at any general meeting of the association unless all money due and payable by the member or proxy to the association has been paid, other than the amount of annual subscription payable in respect of the then current year.

## APPOINTMENT OF PROXIES

32.

1. Each member shall be entitled to appoint another member as proxy by notice given to the secretary no later than 24 hours before the time of the meeting in respect of which the proxy is appointed.
2. The notice appointing the proxy shall be in the form set out in Appendix 2 to these rules.

## PART V

### MISCELLANEOUS

#### INSURANCE

33.

1. The association shall effect and maintain insurance pursuant to section 44 of the Act.
2. In addition to the insurance required under clause (1), the association may effect and maintain other insurance.

## FUNDS – SOURCE

34.

1. The funds of the association shall be derived from entrance fees and annual subscriptions of members, donations and, subject to any resolutions passed by the association in general meeting, such other sources as the committee determines.
2. All money received by the association shall be deposited as soon as practicable and without deduction to the credit of the association's bank account.
3. The association shall, as soon as practicable after receiving any money, issue an appropriate receipt.

## FUNDS – MANAGEMENT

35.

1. Subject to any resolution passed by the association in general meeting, the funds of the association shall be used in pursuance of the object of the association in such a manner as the committee determines.
2. All cheques, drafts, bills of exchange, promissory notes and other negotiable instruments shall be signed by any 2 members of the committee or employees of the association, being members or employees authorised to do so by the committee.

## ALTERATION OF OBJECTS AND RULES

36. The statement of objects and these rules may be altered, rescinded or added to only by a special resolution of the association.

## COMMON SEAL

37.

1. The common seal of the association shall be kept in the custody of the public officer.
2. The common seal shall not be affixed to any instrument by the authority of the committee and the affixing of the common seal shall be attested by the signatures either of 2 members of the committee or 1 member of the committee and of the public officer or secretary.

## CUSTODY OF BOOKS ETC.

38. Except as otherwise provided by these rules, the public officer shall keep in his or her custody or under his or her control all records, books and other documents relating to the association.

## INSPECTION OF BOOKS ETC.

39. The records, books and other documents of the association shall be open to inspection, free of charge, by a member of the association at any reasonable hour.

## SERVICE OF NOTICES

40.

1. For the purpose of these rules, a notice may be served by or on behalf of the association upon any member either personally or by sending it by post to the member at the member's address shown in the registration of members.
2. Where a document is sent to a person by properly addressing, prepaying and posting to the person a letter containing the document, the document shall, unless the contrary is proved, be deemed for the purpose of these rules to have been served on the person at the time at which the letter would have been delivered in the ordinary course of post.

## SURPLUS PROPERTY

41. Omitted by amendment to the Association Incorporation Act, 1984

## PART VI

### ADDITIONAL RULES APPLICABLE TO CHARITIES

#### APPLICATION OF PART

42. This Part applies where the association is registered under or is exempted from registration by or under the Charitable Collections Act, 1934.

#### PAYMENT ETC. OF OFFICE-BEARERS AND MEMBERS

43. A member of the committee shall not be appointed to any salaried office of the association or any office of the association paid fees, and no remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the association to any member or the committee except-

- (a) repayment of out-of-pocket expenses;
- (b) interest at a rate no exceeding interest at the rate for the time being which is or would be charged by the association's bankers for money lent to the association; and
- (c) reasonable and proper rent for premises let to the association.

#### VACATION OF OFFICE

44. Without limiting the operation of rule 17, the office of a member of the committee shall become vacant if-

- (a) the member holds an office of a profit in the association;
- (b) the member is directly or indirectly interested in any contract or proposed contract with the association.

#### SURPLUS PROPERTY

45. Omitted by amendment to the Association Incorporation Act, 1984.

## NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED ALTERATION OF RULES

46. A proposed alteration of the rules or of the statement of objects of the association shall be notified to the Minister administering the Charitable Collections Act, 1934, in the manner required by the regulations under that Act.

## COMPLIANCE WITH CHARITABLE COLLECTIONS ACT, 1934

47. The association shall comply with such of the provisions of the Charitable Collections Act, 1934, and the regulations thereunder as are applicable to it.

## JUNIOR MEMBERS

48.

1. A Junior Member shall be a male or female under 16 years of age who pays the prescribed fees for such membership.
2. On attaining the age of 16 years a Junior Member may continue in that category until the end of the financial year in which his/her birthday occurred.
3. No Junior Member shall be eligible for election to the Committee of the Club.

## HONORARY LIFE MEMEBRS

49. As a mark of the highest honour the Committee may by a two-thirds majority recommend the granting of Honorary Life Membership to any member who in their opinion has rendered outstanding service to the Club and/or the sport of game fishing. Such recommendation shall be submitted to the next Annual General Meeting of the Club and if approved by a majority of members present and entitled to vote, the nominee shall be declared an Honorary Life Member.

## HONORARY MEMBERS

50. The committee may extend Honorary Membership to any person, who, in their opinion, warrants same, Such membership is to be reviewed each year at the first meeting of the Committee after Annual General Meeting.

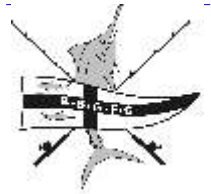

### 1. The Competition

- (a) Points will only be awarded to financial members of the Botany Bay GFC.  
Fishing on a club registered boat on a day listed as a point score day on the Club fishing calendar.
- (b) Captures by honorary members will be awarded boat points only and will not qualify for angler trophies.
- (c) Honorary members may only fish 2 days per season.
- (d) Life Members are not required to be members of the St George Motor Boat Club to fish competition days, non point score days & away from home competitions.
- (e) To be registered with the Club, all boats must be fitted with:
  - i. All appropriate equipment required by the Maritime Services (including an 406 MHz EPIRB); and
  - ii. A 2 MEG SSB radio fitted with frequency 2284; and / or
  - iii. A VHF radio fitted with channel 21
- (f) All competitions will be fished under GFAA and NSWGFA rules that are current as well as Club rules that are current.

### 2. Transfer or Cancellation of Fishing Days

- a. If it is deemed necessary, the committee of the Club has the power to cancel, alter or transfer dates that have been set down in the yearly calendar.
- b. A point score will be called off before the start of fishing if a gale warning is already current
- c. If during a point score day a gale warning is issued, fishing is to cease immediately and the remainder of the day cancelled. Fish that been hooked and are being played should be cut off immediately and vessels should return to nearest port.
- d. Any fish captured or tagged after the warning has been issued will not be counted in the point score competition.
- e. It is up to skippers and crew to keep a radio watch at all times, not hearing is not an excuse.
- f. The committee accepts no responsibility for boats and crews that decide to go to sea or to remain at sea during such warning. On return to port the sched boat or operator must be notified.

### 3. Fishing Times

Fishing times shall be 7.30am to 4.30pm EST and 7.30am to 5.30pm DST

In the event of a fish being hooked but not boated before the end of fishing, such a fish may be played out, and if captured or tagged, will be counted in the point score competitions.

### 4. Fishing Territories

Fishing territory will be from Barrenjoey Light to the north and Port Kembla stacks in the south, degrees of south latitude 220024 and 34.29

This is a hook up area only, A fish may be played outside this area as long as the hook up took place inside the area defined.

### 5. Weigh Station

All captures for the Club point score must be weighed on the day of capture at the Club's official weigh station, unless competing in a recognized outside tournament (eg Port Stephens or Central Zone Comps) or under other circumstances authorised by the committee.

### 6. Fishing Rules and Ethics

All captures and / or tag and release must be made in accordance with the rules and ethics, as set down by the GFAA and NSWGFA.

You are reminded to give clear water to any boat playing a fish, particularly if you have been asked to do so.

Courtesy should also be shown to boats that have established a burley slick, by not motoring through or pulling up and commencing fishing in it.

### 7. Lines

On all occasions, fish captures must be registered on the line class intended when the capture was made. GFAA now only recognize the nominated line category.

### 8. Capture and T&R Certificates

All capture claims must be made on the Club's official capture certificate. The certificate must be completed as full as possible and those items marked with an asterisk (\*) are mandatory. An incomplete certificate shall render the capture liable to disqualification.

Capture and T&R certificates and the tag cards

Point Score Days

All certificates must be received by no later than 7 days after point score.

Non Point Score Days

All certificated must be received within 7 days.

Central Zone Tournament

If fishing a Central Zone Tournament then certificates must be received no later than COB "Close of Business" on Monday after the tournament.

Away From Home

If fishing away from home then certificates must be received no later than 7 days after returning to home port.

If the certificate is not received as per the rules set above that shall render the capture or T&R liable to disqualification.

### 9. Tags

The use of the correct tags must be used in fish as per GFAA & NSWGFA rules set down, the use of incorrect tags shall render the T&R liable to disqualification, the excuse of we didn't have the right tag will not be allowed, if you need tags contact the club recorder.

### 10. Record Claims

Take care that all GFAA rules and requirements are met if a potential record claim is to be made. Lines, hook rigs, traces, double line that is needed before the line is cut. Capture certificates, record claim forms, Line, leader, photographs etc, must be in the hands of either the Club Secretary or Club Recorder within 7 days of the capture date.

It is the anglers responsibility to see that all is in order with a record claim when it is presented to the Club Secretary or Club Recorder so that the Club fishing committee may check out and authenticate such claims before forwarding to the appropriate body of State, Australian or World Record claim.

### 11. Tackle

Your tackle must at all times meet the GFAA rules. The Club reserves the right to inspect any or all tackle at any time, and to measure or check all equipment when deemed necessary.

If your gear does not meet the requirements, it will lead to disqualification of the capture or tag and release.

### 12. Capture Point Score – as per NSWGA Current Point Score System

Marlin - Broadbill	Double Points
Blue Sharks	One Quarter Points
Other Sharks	Half Points
Other Game Fish	Treble Points (excepting Broadbill as per NSWGFA Point Score)

### 13. Tag & Release Point Score – as per NSWGFA Current Point Score System

Points will be awarded as per NSWGFA current Tag & Release point score system.

### 15. Minimum Weights and Points Limits

#### Yellowfin Tuna

On line classes up to and including 15kg, it is a 15kg minimum weight.

On line classes over 15kg, it is equal to line class.

Junior anglers, it is equal to the line class in all cases.

#### Southern Bluefin Tuna

On line classes up to and including 15kg, it is a 15kg minimum weight.

On line classes over 15kg, it is equal to line class.

Junior anglers, it is equal to the line class in all cases.

## Marlin

On line classes up to 10kg, it is a 60kg minimum and 80kg on line classes 15kg and over.

## Sharks

On line classes up to 10kg, it is a 60kg minimum and 80kg minimum on line classes 15kg, 24kg and 37kg and on 60kg line the minimum is 120kg.

## Other Game Fish and Broadbill

Minimum weight to equal line class.

## 16. Maximum Points

For all species on a 4kg, 6kg, 8kg and 10kg line is 15,000 plus 1 point per kilo.

For all species on 15kg, 24kg, 37kg and 60kg line is 20,000 plus 1 point per kilo.

## 17. Tackle Sections

The Club recognizes four tackle sections:

Ultra Light Tackle	4kg and 6kg tackle
Light Tackle	8kg and 10kg tackle
Medium Tackle	15kg and 24kg tackle
Heavy Tackle	37kg and 60kg tackle

Note: Sharks captured on 4kg with not be recognized for Club point score.

## 18. Radio Procedures

- a. All boat participating in the Club point score are to sign on with the Gamefish Base or Sched boat for that day at the start of fishing, giving the number of person on board.
- b. All boats are to use 2 MEG SSB on prescribed channels or VHF on prescribed channels at 10 minutes to the hour, every hour, giving your position, fishing method, and captures using the 0.0.0 system.
- c. Any boat unable to contact Gamefish Base or Sched boat must make contact with another Club boat and arrange a relay of its report and position.
- d. If any boat does not make contact on two consecutive scheds, a search by the relevant authority may be instigated. This could be at your own expense.
- e. All Boats are required to sign off at the end of fishing when entering port. If you are unable to make radio contact, notify the weigh station or find a committee member to sign off with. This is your responsibility.
- f. There shall be 10,000 capture and tag and release penalty levied against any boat that
  - i. Fails to contact Gamefish Base or Sched boat for two consecutive scheds after signing on or not contacting another boat to relay for them; or
  - ii. Fails to sign off after returning to port with Gamefish Base or Sched boat or Committee member.

- g. There may be a penalty of 500 capture and tag and release points for:
- i. Any boat not flying capture or tag and release flags when passing between the Captain Cook Bridge and the weigh station.

IF A VESSEL HAS A RADIO FAILURE AND CANNOT CONTACT GAMEFISH BASE OR SCHED BOAT OR RELAY THROUGH ANOTHER VESSEL, IT MUST RETURN TO PORT AND NOTIFY RADIO BASE OF THEIR ACTIONS BY OTHER MEANS (PHONE ETC.).

### 19. Interclub Tournament Entries

All Interclub entry forms for the NSWGFA tournament must be sent to the Botany Bay Game Fishing Club Secretary for processing.

### 20. Non Point Score Competition

These competitions run from 1<sup>st</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> May. This is to allow all awards to be allocated before our presentation function. This still gives you 12 months fishing time.

### 21. Non Point Score Regulations

All captures or tag and releases are to be fished:

- a. Under GFAA and NSWGFA rules
- b. On a Club registered boat
- c. Captures or tags to be weighed or handed in on any other than point score day contact a committee member or weigh master to arrange the use of scales. Fish can be weighed the next day if you cannot make arrangements on the day of capture
- d. Capture certificates or tag cards with certificates to be in the hands of the Club's Recorder within 7 days of the capture or by 2<sup>nd</sup> June, whichever comes first. Anglers do not need to be members
- e. Captures or tag and release that will not qualify are:
  - i. Made on a boat under charter
  - ii. Fish caught or tagged before or after fishing time on a point score day.
- f. Trophies are awarded in the following categories:
  - i. Heaviest Billfish
  - ii. Heaviest Shark
  - iii. Heaviest other game fish: and
  - iv. Champion boat tag & release.

### 22. Away From Home Angler Competition

This competition is run between 1<sup>st</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> May.

- a. All captures or tag and releases must be caught under GFAA and NSWGFA rules,
- b. Anglers must be Club members.
- c. Fish caught or tagged on any boat, including charter boats, on the coast of NSW (other than Botany Bay).
- d. Fish may be weighed by an official of game fishing club or on certified scales.
- e. All captures or tag and release whilst travelling to a recognized competition included on our fishing calendar.

- f. Capture certificates or tag cards with certificates, must be completed and forwarded to our Club Recorder within 7 days of returning to home port, or by 2<sup>nd</sup> June, after completion of tournament, whichever comes first.

### Fish not eligible

- a. Fish caught or tagged before or after time in a competition that is included in our calendar.
- b. Fish caught or tagged when returning home and weighed at home port, these are eligible for our non point score competition if not on a point score day or eligible for point score if on Club point score day.
- c. Any fish caught on a point score day.
- d. Trophies will be awarded in the following categories.
  - i. Heaviest Billfish
  - ii. Heaviest Shark
  - iii. Heaviest other game fish; and
  - iv. Highest point scoring angler tag and release.

### 23. Committee

The Committee of the Club, as elected by the members, shall be responsible for all decisions and adjudication of disputes regarding the point score, non point score and away from home competitions and allocation of trophies.

## Botany Bay Game Fishing Club Competition Rules

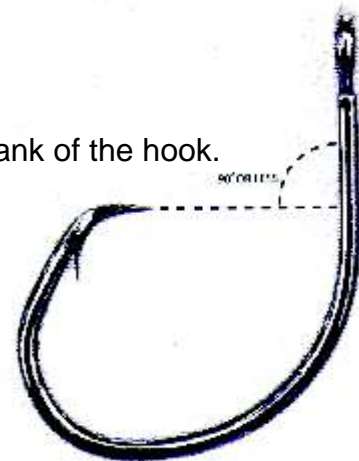
**CIRCLE HOOKS ONLY** are permitted to be used for livebaiting and trolling natural baits.

NB: no points to be scored for any species caught while using livebaits and/or trolling natural baits with "J" hooks. (rule comes into effect on 29th July 2010)

### Circle Hook Definition:

A hook with its point turned 90 degrees or less back towards the shank of the hook.

"If an imaginary line is drawn and follows the trajectory of the point of the hook to the shank – the angle made where the imaginary line crosses the shank should be 90 degrees or less."



## 2011 – 2012 Tag & Release – Capture Certificates.

### Point Score Days

All Certificates must be received by no later than the Wednesday after point score.

### Non Point Score Days

All Certificates must be received within 7 days.

### Central Zone Tournaments

If fishing a central zone tournament then Certificates must be received no later than COB on Tuesday after the tournament.



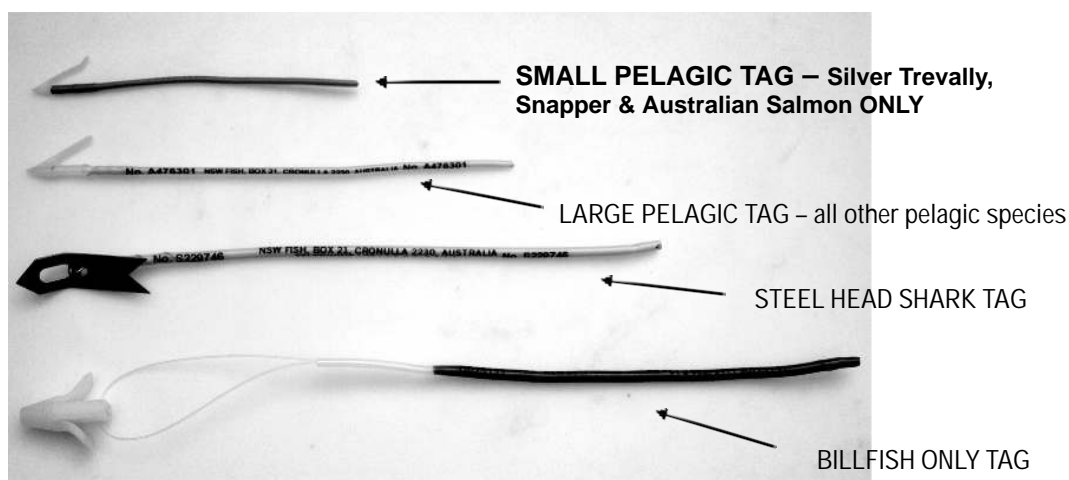

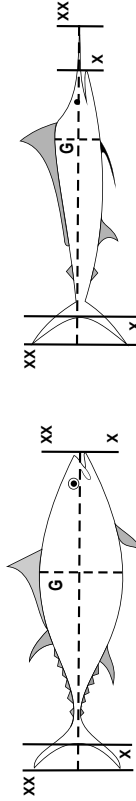

# FISHING RULES FOR CENTRAL ZONE TOURNAMENTS

SEASON 2011 / 2012



1. The Zonal Chairman, who represents N.S.W.G.FAA, organises Central Zone (CZ) Tournaments on behalf of the Zone's registered Clubs. Tournaments are open to all financial members of CZ Clubs, which are currently -

Central Coast Game Fishing Club  
Broken Bay Game Fishing Club  
Sydney Bay Game Fishing Club

Botany Bay Game Fishing Club  
Port Hacking Game Fishing Club  
Wollongong Game Fishing Club

Any future clubs that are accepted within the Zone can participate.

## 1.1 Zonal Waters

Central Zone Waters are the coastal waters within the bounded areas by **32.50 000S (Grid ref "Bravo")** in the north and **35.15.000S** in the south (**Grid ref "Zulu South 4"**). The eastern boundary will vary with the host club's relevant eastern boundary.

Each round of the Central Zone Tournament will be fished within the prescribed waters of the host Club. Areas within CZ waters overall, but outside the host club's waters, are therefore OUT-OF-BOUNDS for that particular round of competition.

## 1.2 Boat Registration

a. All Boats wishing to fish the Central Zone Competition must be registered with their respective clubs and comply with their Club Safety Rules. Each Club must provide the Central Zone Chairman if requested with a copy of the **Current Club or Central Zone Boat Registration Form** for any boats intending to fish in the Central Zone. **This form must provide all other information** relating to Safety, Radios and information that may be of use for safety purposes. No boat shall participate in any Zone event without compliant requirements.

b. Central Zone requires that each competing vessel have Public Liability Insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 Million. Details of the current insurance cover must be included on the Boat Safety form. No vessel will be eligible without this information being completed.

## 1.3 Event Registration

**1.3 (a)** It is not compulsory for boats fishing the Central Zone Tournament to enter the Host Club's Tournament, but they are encouraged to do so, **however if a boat elects to not enter the host clubs tournament THEY WILL ONLY BE ELIGIBLE TO FISH ONE DAY OF THAT CZ ROUND, it can be either Saturday or Sunday as they elect in line with rule 1.3.(b)**

1.3 (b) Club Secretaries must advise the Central Zone Chairman of the name of Boats competing and the number of anglers attending dinner on the 1<sup>st</sup> night of the tournament **by 7.30pm on the Wednesday before the Tournament**

The Zone Chairman will advise the Host Club of arrangements to be made for berthing, food and all other facilities required. All entries after 7.30pm on the cut off day will be considered a Late Entry' and will attract an Additional fee of \$20.00. **NO** entries will be accepted after 7.30pm on the evening preceding the event.

## 1.4 Entry Fee / Boat Registration

An annual fee of \$100 is to be paid to the respective clubs CZ co-ordinator at the beginning of the new season, this will be in-turn forwarded to the CZ Chairman before the first round of CZ. Boats wishing to join the CZ competition will be able to register on the Wednesday prior to the tournament & a fee of \$25 will be collected by their respective clubs CZ co-ordinator before any points will be counted for that boat.



It will be the responsibility of each club's CZ representative to collect **ALL** fees for all boats that enter any round of CZ whether yearly or per Round.

If a Club advises the Central Zone Chairman that a boat is registered and the boat does not participate in the event, the Club must still pay the Fee and payment must be remitted on the evening of the event.

### **1.5 1<sup>st</sup> Night Meal**

The Host Club may provide a meal on the 1st Night at a Maximum Charge of **\$20.00** per head. If the host club has an alternative catering arrangement they can make this available to participating anglers. Anglers are requested to participate in the evening meal if provided by the Host Club.

### **1.6 Zonal Committee**

In the event of any disputes, protests, misconduct etc. the **Zonal Committee will consist** of the Club Presidents (or their representatives) under the Chairmanship of the Central Zone Chairman. Should the Central Zone Chairman be unavailable then the Host Club President shall Chair the Meeting. If a meeting is required at least 3 clubs plus the chairman are to be present. If a rule relating to competition is not specifically covered under the Central Zone Rules then the Tournament rules of the host club will apply to all boats and Anglers whether entered in the host Club's tournament or not.

### **1.6a Conduct**

It is the expectation that all participants will conduct themselves in a responsible and courteous manner to the Tournament Officials, other Competitors and the general public at all times during a tournament.

Penalties for misconduct may include loss of points or disqualification from a Central Zone tournament round or other penalties that may be determined **by the Zonal Committee**

### **1.7 Bad Weather**

To avoid taking unnecessary risks in the event of bad weather, the Host Club Tournament Committee will decide whether the day will be a Tournament Day or not. Skippers should establish contact with the Tournament Committee if they consider the event will not or may not proceed.

In the event of the Weather Bureau issuing a weather report which is a "Gale Warning" or a higher category of warning affecting a particular day of the Tournament then the Host Club will automatically cancel that day's fishing. If a "Gale Warning" or higher category of warning is issued after the commencement of fishing only those fish captured or tagged at the time fishing is cancelled or prior will count towards pointscore. Any fish still being played which is subsequently captured or tagged will not count towards the Club, Boat or Angler's pointscore for Central Zone or the Saturday night awards. On the issuing of a "Gale Warning" or "higher category of warning" all Boats should immediately return to Port.

It is the responsibility of every boat owner/skipper to be aware of the sea conditions and decide if these conditions are safe to operate in. The Zone Chairman, N.S.W.G.F.A or the Host Club shall in no way be responsible for any loss or damage, or injury occasioned by the vessel putting to sea or remaining at sea in conditions the vessel cannot operate safely in.

### **1.8 Ineligible Boats**

The Host Club, or Central Zone Chairman, will advise via 2meg Channel 2284, the VHF Channel as nominated by the host Club and Channel 27.940 Radio on the Sunday, and any participating boats not eligible to score points; i.e. non attendance or Register not signed by two crew members of the participating Boat at the Saturday Evening Meal / BBQ.



## **1.9 Communications**

Communications will be conducted on 2Meg Channel 2284, 27Meg Channel 27.940 or the VHF Channel as nominated by the host Club. It is the Host Club's responsibility to provide 2 Meg and 27 Meg or VHF relay to Game Fish Base. Participating Boats must inform the Host Club on what radio frequency they will be using before the event. In the event of a vessel not answering two consecutive radio schedules, the Host Club MUST proceed with "Missing Vessel Report", as per current N.S.W.G.F.A regulations.

## **2. ANGLING RULES**

Shall be per G.F.A.A and N.S.W. G.F.A Rules as published in each Association's Rule Book as current at the date of the Tournament Event.

### **2.1 Point Score**

### **2.2 Weighing of Fish**

- Fish captured on **Saturday must be weighed at the Host Club Weigh Station** and will only be accepted when brought to the station by boat. Fish or Tag cards may NOT be delivered by any other means i.e. by road etc. *In extreme circumstances only the Zonal Committee as defined in rule 1.6, may consider an alternative method of delivery of the Tag Card.(eg. marina closure due to weather conditions)*
- Fish caught on **Sunday may be weighed at the competing boat's homeport.** Details must be reported to the Central Zone Chairman as per rule 2.3b.

### **2.3 Recording of Tag & Release**

- Tag & Release cards for Saturday/1<sup>st</sup> Tournament Day must be accompanied by a Capture Certificate and be presented to the Weigh Master of the Host Club. NB: Tag & Release Cards will only be accepted from boats subject to Rule 2.2a.
- Tag & Release results for Sunday or 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the tournament must be communicated to the Central Zone Chairman by respective Club Secretaries/Fishing Co-ordinator by Facsimile, Mail or Email (TELEPHONE CALLS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED) As soon as possible but no later than 14 DAYS FOLLOWING THE TOURNAMENT. Tournament results that are NOT received by 4.30p.m on that day WILL NOT BE COUNTED.
- All Tag & Release cards or accompanying Capture Certificates must clearly show the TIME the fish was Tagged & Released. Tag & Release cards not showing the time of release will be deemed to be caught at the cut off time at the weigh station for the last for the day of the tournament in the case of a count back.
- Tag Cards must clearly show the line class used to catch the fish. If no line class is nominated on the Tag Card it will be deemed to be caught on 60kg.

### **2.4 Recording of Captures**

- All Capture Certificates for Saturday must be presented to the Central Zone Chairman or his nominated representative at the Host Club via the Weigh master. Capture results for Sunday or the last day of the tournament must be communicated to the Central Zone Chairman as for Tag & Release Rule 2.3b
- All Capture Certificates must clearly show THE TIME of Capture. PLEASE NOTE: Strict adherence to Rules 2.3b and 2.4b will allow the Central Zone Chairman to have complete results of the Tournament back to Club Secretaries within seven (7) days

### **2.5 Radio Schedules**

Will be conducted by the Host Club according to NSWGFA regulations.

Only Capture and Tag and Release results recorded **by 8.00pm** on the 1<sup>st</sup> night of the tournament round will be eligible for a Sponsor's contribution for the highest point scoring BOAT in both Capture and Tag & Release, and a bottle of Spirits for the winning SENIOR ANGLER in both Capture & T&R, in respect of the first day's results. A daily prize will also be awarded to the Champion Junior Angler in both T&R and Capture. In the event of a tie, a 'Count Back' will decide the winner.

# NOTICE

Recently an email was distributed to selected NSWGFA affiliated anglers regarding a potential

The author of this email made statements regarding the legality of the NSWGFA By-law - "***participation in non-sanctioned tournaments***".

### **NSWGFA affiliated members are reminded:**

1. NSWGFA rules and by-laws are determined by the NSWGFA Full Council (i.e. Delegates from all NSWGFA Member Clubs) at an Annual or General Meeting of the Association as per NSWGFA Constitution.
2. All NSWGFA rules and by-laws remain in force until such time that the NSWGFA Full Council determine an amendment etc., to these rules and/or by-laws, this can only happen at a properly constituted meeting of the Full Council.
3. The NSWGFA by-law "***participation in non-sanctioned tournaments***" is a constitutionally legal by-law and is in force therefore as a consequence of fishing such a tournament a vessel/angler could face disciplinary action.
